Dear property owner:

The Kentucky Communications Network Authority (KCNA) was established in August 2015 to oversee the design, construction and operation of the KentuckyWired statewide fiber optic network. This 3,400 mile network will be constructed in every county in the Commonwealth and will provide internet service to state government offices as well as provide a robust middle-mile network to increase internet speed and capacity. You are being contacted today because the architect of the network (Black & Veatch Corporation, On Behalf of NG-KIH DB LLC) has determined that the network must traverse your property. To enable the Commonwealth to construct the network, the Commonwealth respectfully requests that you consider granting it an easement for its contractors to access your property – only as necessary – to construct and maintain the network.

The person who is contacting you is a land agent sub-contractor hired by Black & Veatch to contact property owners to discuss the easement. To address your concerns that the person who will or has contacted you was hired by Black & Veatch, a list of the land agents and their companies is attached to this letter.

The Commonwealth understands that you were unaware you would be contacted in this way and apologizes for the inconvenience.
