- 2. a **Plan Framework** phase in which a "straw" plan based on the opportunities outlined by the workgroups is drafted.
- 3. a *Plenary* phase in which members from all workgroups convene to review and refine the strategies outlined in the "straw" plan.
- 4. a *Plan Completion* phase, in which a refined draft is reviewed and finalized.
